ORDINANCE NO. 2385

AN ORDINANCE carrying over appropriations totaling \$3,536,485 from entitlements 1 and 2 in the Federal Shared Revenue Fund in support of programs and projects authorized by ordinance, amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 66, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. 




