BE IT ORDAINDED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation in the amount of \$28,900 to

Special Programs, Dependent Juveniles Study, from unappropriated

1974 Current Expense Fund balance is hereby approved and adopted.

 $\underline{\text{SECTION 2}}$. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 49, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to: Special Programs $((\$2_7948_7668))$ $\$2_797_7,568$

PROVIDED THAT:

All applicable provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2230, as amended, shall be fulfilled.

PROVIDED FURTHER THAT:

King County's financial responsibility pursuant to the first year of this two year pilot project shall not exceed the \$28,900 herewithin appropriated, exclusive of in kind contributions.

King County's financial responsibility pursuant to the second year of this two year pilot project shall be dependent upon both an evaluation by the County Council of the accomplishments of the first year and the availability of funds.

The Department of Social and Health Services (DSHS), State of Washington, will be the lead agency for the two year pilot project and it is the intention of the County Council that DSHS will assume major responsibility for any ongoing activity that stems either directly or indirectly from the pilot project.

The purpose of the two year pilot project is coordination and referral and no other direct services shall be provided. No grant funds shall be applied for to expand financial support for the project beyond the present participants without the express and prior

consent of the King County Council. The County Executive or his designee shall be responsible for directing the County's participation in this two year pilot project and shall ensure that the affected Youth Services Bureaus, the Division of Youth Affairs and the Department of Public Safety participate to the fullest extent possible in all phases of project activity including making the referrals in their respective areas.
