ORDINANCE NO. 2469

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$1,957,004 to the fiscal year 1975-76 CETA Title II Fund, and appropriating \$4,514,237 to the CETA Title VI Fund, establishing a new fund and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 2230.

\$6,471,241 has been made available to King County through June 30, 1976 by the United States Department of Labor through King/Snohomish Manpower Consortium; \$1,957,004 under CETA Title II and \$4,514,237 under CETA Title VI.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

Section 1. A new fund is hereby created, entitled Fiscal Year 1975-76 CETA Title II fund to receive and disburse funds received under Title II.

Section 2. An amount of \$1,957,004 is hereby appropriated to the Fiscal Year 1975-76 CETA Title II fund and allocated to:

And an amount of \$4,514,237 is appropriated to the existing CETA Title VI fund and allocated to:

- 1. Following completion of specified activities, the Executive shall recommend for Council approval by motion, no later than October 15, 1975, CETA positions which should be funded effective January 1, 1976.
- 2. Requests for continuation of CETA public agency positions, currently funded through December 31, 1975, or requests for new positions thereafter shall be evaluated against the following criteria presented in their order of importance:
 - A. Commitment by the applicant agency to absorb the qualified employee, ideally at the end of the federal fiscal year, based on a logical discussion of normal attrition in the agency leading to identify local revenue supported position vacancies.
 - B. Agency prioritized need.
 - C. Suitability to both long-term and recent unemployed.
 - D. Transition potential.
 - E. Preference to types of positions normally funded over limited term project positions.
