

ORDINANCE NO. 2470

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$10,000 to the Public Health Pooling Fund for support of the Mental Health Nursing Program and amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 54, as amended.

STATEMENT OF INTENT:

It is the intent of the King County Council that the appropriation contained herein shall be used to test the effectiveness of the Mental Health Nursing Program and to test the concept of using paraprofessionals as supplementary aides to Public Health Nurses. Nothing contained herein shall commit King County to funding beyond this appropriation.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$10,000 is hereby approved and adopted to the Public Health Pooling Fund from the Public Health Pooling Fund's 1975 unappropriated revenue for support of the Mental Health Nursing Program.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 54, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Public Health Pooling Fund there is hereby appropriated: ((~~\$3,940,497~~)) \$3,950,497

PROVIDED THAT:

1. The provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2230, as subsequently amended, shall be fulfilled.

2. Nurses' duties shall be confined to those requiring professional nursing expertise.
