

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation of \$39,200 to the Grant Fund for the Burien Area Transportation Study, Phase I and amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 60, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

Since the 1964 Comprehensive Plan for King County was adopted many dramatic changes have taken place including:

- a) Sudden changes in population and employment growth pattern;
- b) Formation of a regional transit system;
- c) Advent of the energy crisis and increased environmental awareness;
- d) Initiation of the process of updating the 1964 King County Comprehensive Plan.

These dramatic changes were recognized and underscored when the Council acknowledged the King County Interim Transportation Plan on September 9th, 1974. Further, the Council has authorized the County Executive by Motion No. 1862 to apply for a technical study grant to determine more detailed transportation needs of Burien-Sea-Tac Community. The Urban Mass Transportation Administration through its Coordinated Support Program has approved a sum of \$39,200 for the study.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The amount of \$39,200 is hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from the Puget Sound Council of Governments, Contract No. 1-6200, for the Burien Area Transportation Study, Phase I, County File No. 550.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$9,800 is hereby acknowledged as an in-kind contractual obligation by King County in support of the Burien Area Transportation Study, Phase I, County File No. 550.
