BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There shall be submitted to the qualified voters of the county for their approval and ratification or rejection, at the next general election to be held in this county, an amendment to Article 6 of the King County Charter:

amending Section 610 thereof to read as follows:

"Except as provided in this Article, the nominating primaries and elections shall be conducted in accordance with general law governing the election of ((partisan)) nonpartisan county officers."

deleting Section 620 thereof, and

renumbering Sections 630 through 690 to reflect the deletion of Section 620.

SECTION 2. The Director of the Division of Records and Elections shall cause notice of the proposed amendment of the King County Charter to be published in accordance with the state constitution and general law.
