

ORDINANCE NO. 2517

AN ORDINANCE relating to levying the property taxes of certain districts of King County for the year 1976.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The County Assessor of King County has certified to the County Council that the assessed valuation of the County of King as finally equalized amounts to \$16,395,985,434 and as adjusted for exemptions provided for in the Laws of Washington Ch. 182, Laws of 1974, First Extraordinary Session and for 20% only of watercraft is \$16,335,681,396.

SECTION 2. The Council of King County, Washington, finds that the amounts of the levies necessary to raise the amounts of the estimated expenditures as so finally determined for the year 1976, less the total of estimated revenues from sources other than taxation, including available surplus, and such expenditures as are to be met from bond warrant issues, be and the same are hereby fixed as follows:




