ORDINANCE NO. 2533

AN ORDINANCE relating to fees for costs of environmental assessments and impact statements; adding a new section to Ordinance 1700 and to KCC 20.44.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

NEW SECTION. SECTION 1. A new section is added to

Ordinance 1700 and KCC 20.44 as follows:

FEES, APPLICATIONS FOR COUNTY ENVIRONMENTAL INVESTIGATION.

The following fees shall be required for applications for

county environmental investigations filed by a person or non-

county agency in addition to the regular application and

inspection fees:

 (1) Actions in classes determined to be without

no fee required;

(2) Actions requiring an individual determination of

environmental significance and resulting in declaration of no significant impact: Provided, That such fee shall not be required of applications made to the Division of Planning and Land Use Management where this fee has been incorporated into the regular application fee:

\$50.00

- (3) Actions requiring preparation for an environmental impact statement:
- (i) \$500.00 to be deposited with the responsible official prior to commencement of preparation of impact statement by the county; plus
- (ii) Additional costs, if any, for hiring experts not employed by the county, tests, printing and for any other actual costs required for the preparation and distribution of the applicant's impact statement: Provided, That no additional costs can be charged for existing studies or general information already in the possession of the county.

1	(iii) Any unexpended balances from deposits made by the
2	applicant shall be returned upon completion of the impact
3	statement.
4	(c) In the case of those actions which require
5	environmental impact statements, the responsible official shall
6	to the maximum extent practicable, consistent with the
7	requirement of producing an adequate environmental impact
8	statement, utilize information, studies and tests and assistance
9	provided by the applicant pursuant to Ordinance 1700, Section 11
10	and KCC 20.44.110 in order to minimize additional costs for the
11	preparation of the impact statement.
12	SECTION 2. This ordinance shall govern applications
13	submitted after its effective date.
