

ORDINANCE NO. 2553

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the maximum amount of \$750,000 to the Grant Fund and the Cedar Hills Construction fund for the construction of alcoholism treatment structures at the King County Cedar Hills Alcoholism Treatment Center; revising the 1975 Capital Improvement budget and amending Ordinance No. 2230, Section 69 and Section 69 Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Funds in the maximum amount of \$750,000 are hereby appropriated to the Grant Fund from a Washington State Department of Social and Health Services Referendum 29 Construction Grant, County File No. 514, for centralized Grant accounting purposes.

SECTION 2. Funds in the maximum amount of \$750,000 are hereby appropriated to the Cedar Hills Construction Fund Residential Care Unit C. I. P. Project No. 004067 from a Washington State Department of Social and Health Services Grant for the construction of two additional alcoholism treatment structures at the King County Cedar Hills Alcoholism Treatment Center; revising the Protection of Health Program 1975 Capital Improvement budget.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2230, Section 69, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:
