AN ORDINANCE relating to the Vacation of a portion of S. W. 176th Street (Vashon Island) V-1487 Petitioner: Gerald E. Sengstock and others.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of S. W. 176th Street (Vashon Island), hereinafter described.
- 2. The report of the Department of Public Works and Transportation and the Department of Community and Environmental Development, Land Use Management Division, finds that the road to be vacated is useless to the County and the vacation would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation.
 - 3. The Quit-Claim Deed was obtained and recorded in 1962.
- 4. It has been determined that the public will be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the Sd day of Coconce, 1975.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION 1. The Council on the Standard day of Docember, 1975 hereby vacates and abandons the portion of S. W. 176th Street (Vashon Island) described as follows:
