

ORDINANCE NO. 2569

AN ORDINANCE relating to extra help
employment of former County employees
over sixty-five (65) years of age;
amending King County Code 3.12.060 (j).

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. King County Code 3.12.060 (j) is hereby amended
to read as follows:

(j) RETIREMENT. Retirement from regular county employment
shall occur on the first of the month following the occurrence of
the sixty-fifth birthday.

Former employees over sixty-five (65) shall be eligible for
extra-help employment on the same basis as other applicants, but
in no event to exceed 520 hours in any one calendar year.
