ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Jolie to King County Water District No. 82.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 82 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Jolie to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Jolie and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Jolie to be annexed is described as follows:

That portion of Section 4, Township 24 North, Range 6 East W.M. described as follows:

The Southwest 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4;

AND

The North 1/2 of the Southeast 1/4 of the Northeast 1/4 LESS the East 300 feet;

AND

The East 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southwest 1/4 LESS the South 300 feet;

AND

The South 1/2 of the North 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 LESS the East 300 feet;

AND

The South 1/2 of the Northeast 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4
LESS the East 300 feet and LESS the South 300 feet;

The Northwest 1/4 of the Southeast 1/4 LESS the South 300
feet and LESS the West 5 acres EXCEPT the North 510 feet
of the West 5 acres.

Containing 117 acres more or less.
