

ORDINANCE NO. 2586

1
2 AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an
3 area known as Resolution 288 to King County
4 Water District No. 81.

5 WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 81 has found the
6 petition for annexation of an area known as Resolution 288 to be
7 sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed
8 annexation; and

9 WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed
10 annexation by the King County Council and the King County
11 Boundary Review Board; and

12 WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in
13 the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county
14 comprehensive plan,

15 THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

16 SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District
17 No. 81 of the area known as Resolution 288 and described in
18 Section 2 herein is approved.

19 SECTION 2. The area known as Resolution 288 to be annexed
20 is described as follows:

21 That portion of Sections 27 and 28, Township 26 North,
22 Range 5 East W.M., described as follows:

23 Beginning at the southeast corner of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$
24 of said Section 27; thence west along the south line of
25 said NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ and along the south line of the NE $\frac{1}{4}$
26 of the SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 28 to a point 180 feet
27 measured radially from the center line of N.E. 120th
28 St. (Krist Knudsen Road No. 2421); thence continue
29 westerly on a line parallel to and 180 feet northerly
30 of said center line to the west line of said NE $\frac{1}{4}$ of the
31 SE $\frac{1}{4}$; thence north along said west line to a point
32 180 feet, measured radially, southeasterly of the center
33 line of Slater Ave. N.E. (J.W. Edwards Road No. 970);
thence easterly along a line parallel to and 180 feet
southerly of said center line to the west line of the
east half of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 27;
thence north along said west line and along the west
line of the east half of the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said
Section 27 to a point 120 feet south of the North line
of the South half of the NW $\frac{1}{4}$ of said Section 27; thence
easterly along a line 120 feet south of and parallel to
the said north line to a point 140 feet, measured
radially, northerly of the center line of N.E. 126th
Pl. (J.D. Lange Co. Rd. 27-26-5-1); thence easterly
along a line 140 feet northerly of and parallel to the
said center line to a point 450 feet east of the west

1 line of the NE¼ of the NW¼ of said Section 27; thence
 2 north along a line 450 feet east of and parallel to the
 3 said west line to a point 570.87 feet south of the
 4 north line of said Section 27; thence east along a line
 5 parallel to and 570.87 feet south of the said north
 6 line 220 feet more or less to a point 670 feet west of
 7 the east line of the NW¼ of said Section 27; thence
 8 north along a line 670 feet west of and parallel to the
 9 said east line to the north line of said Section 27;
 10 thence east along said north line 1100 feet more or less
 11 to the center line of the Snoqualmie Branch of the
 Burlington Northern Railroad; thence southerly along the
 said center line to a point 200 feet, measured at right
 angles, southerly of the center line of N.E. 124th St.
 (Rev'n) as established January 14, 1963, C.C. vol.
 72/140 survey 28-26-5-6A; thence westerly along a line
 200 feet south of and parallel to said center line to
 the east line of NW¼ of the SW¼ of said Section 27;
 thence south along said east line to the southeast
 corner of said NW¼ of the SW¼ which is the Point of
 Beginning.
