AN ORDINANCE relating to charging fees for travel certification and increasing fees, amending Ordinance No. 344, Section 2 as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 344, Section 2, and K.C.C. 2.24.090 is hereby amended to read as follows:

As of the effective date of the Ordinance codified in this Section and Section 2.24.080 ((a-fee-of-three-dollars-shall-be charged-for-each-travel-certificate-attesting-that-required immunizations-were-performed-by-personnel-of-the-Seattle-King County-Department-of-Public-Health,-and-a-fee-of-one-dollar-shall be-charged-for-each-travel-certificate-attesting-that-required immunizations-were-performed-by-persons-other-than-personnel-of the-Seattle-King-County-Department-of-Public-Health.)) each traveler shall be charged a fee of five dollars (\$5.00) per trip for providing any or all of the following: the provision or updating of the international travel certificate, the required and recommended immunizations or a signed letter of exemption, and immunization validation. Each traveler shall be charged a fee of two dollars (\$2.00) per trip for the immunization validation attesting that required immunizations and travel certificates have been provided by persons other than personnel of the Seattle-King County Department of Public Health.
