ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE relating to Television Reception District No. 1, King County, Washington, increasing the number of Board members from three to five, amending Ordinance No. 1425, Section 2.

PREAMBLE:

King County Ordinance No. 1425 established Television Reception Improvement District No. 1, King County, Washington, in Skykomish precinct and a portion of Stevens precinct, with three board members to conduct the business of the district. It now appears in the public interest to expand the number of board members from three to five, so as to more readily provide representation for a newly served area within the district.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1425, Section 2, is hereby amended as follows:

There is hereby established a Board of Television Reception

Improvement District No. 1, King County, Washington, to be composed of

((three)) five members appointed by the King County Council. Each member shall reside within the boundaries of the district. Each member shall serve a three-year term except that on the first board one of the members shall be appointed to a one year term and two to two year terms.

A majority of the members of the board shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, but the majority vote of the board members shall

1	be necessary for any action taken by the board. The board shall elect from
2	its members a chairman and such other officers as may be necessary. In
3	the event a vacancy occurs prior to the expiration of the member's term,
4	the Council shall appoint a person to complete the unexpired term.
