

ORDINANCE NO. 2615

AN ORDINANCE authorizing reimbursement to a King County officer or employee for any expense incurred in the course of "lobbying" as defined in RCW 42.17.020(18) and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:


SECTION 1. Any expense for which a King County officer or employee would otherwise be reimbursed shall be a legal obligation of and expenditure by King County when incurred in the course of "lobbying" as defined in RCW 42.17.020(18), or in the course of providing requested information to an official or officials of another governmental agency.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
