

ORDINANCE NO. 2621

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$71,677 to the Grant Fund from the Snohomish County Metropolitan Municipal Corporation for King County participation in a water quality planning program being conducted in the Snoqualmie River Basins under provisions of the Federal Water Quality Control Act Amendments of 1972 (P.L. 92-500), allocating these funds to the King County Department of Planning and Community Development, Planning Division in accordance with a mutually agreed upon work program.

BE IT ORDAINTED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$71,677 to the Grant Fund to support King County participation in the Snohomish County Metropolitan Municipal Corporation's water quality planning program is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. The King County Department of Planning and Community Development, Planning Division shall use funds allocated to them for the completion of the following program tasks as described in the SNOMET/King County area wide Waste Management Planning Study Work Program.




