AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Capital Budget and Program, appropriating unanticipated revenue in the estimated amount of \$150,000 from the City of Seattle Water Department to the Park Acquisition and Development Fund for the Lake Washington Seattle North Trail, and revising the 1976 Park Capital Improvement Budget; amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68 and Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of unanticipated revenue in the estimated amount of \$150,000 from the City of Seattle Water Department to the Park Acquisition and Development Fund for the construction of a watermain at the Lake Washington - Seattle North Trail Project No. 007152.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, Attachment No. 1, as amended, is hereby revised as depicted on the attached Capital Budget information sheet.

SECTION 4. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.


