ORDINANCE NO. 2626

AN ORDINANCE amending Chapter 3, Section 2 and Section 14 of Ordinance 2096, which includes the Uniform Mechanical Code, 1973 Edition, and K.C.C. 16.12.020 and 16.12.140.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2096, Chapter 3, Section 2 and K.C.C. 16.12.020 is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 201(a) GENERAL. The Building and Land Development Division Manager is hereby authorized and directed to enforce all the provisions of this code (~~((including the Fuel Gas Piping requirements of Chapter 22 for single installations of comfort heating equipment only; the remaining multiple installations requirements contained in Chapter 22 of Appendix B, Fuel Gas Piping; shall be enforced by the Director of Public Health))~~) except the Fuel Gas Piping requirements of Chapter 22, Appendix B, shall be enforced by the Director of Public Health. For such purpose they shall have the powers of a police officer.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2096, Chapter 3, Section 14 and K.C.C. 16.12.140, Title of Chapter 22 of Appendix B, is hereby amended to read as follows:




