

ORDINANCE NO. 2649

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Michael to King County Water District No. 105.

WHEREAS, King County Water District No. 105 has found the petition for annexation of an area known as Michael to be sufficient and has, by resolution, concurred with the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, state law requires approval of the proposed annexation by the King County Council and the King County Boundary Review Board; and

WHEREAS, the King County Council finds said annexation is in the public interest and is not inconsistent with the county comprehensive plan,

THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 105 of the area known as Michael and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Michael to be annexed is described as follows:

The Southwest 1/4 of the Northwest 1/4 of Section 36, Township 22N Range 5 EWM, all in King County, Washington.
