

ORDINANCE NO. 2655

1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$153,000 in  
2 unanticipated revenue from the State of  
3 Washington Department of Social & Health  
4 Services to the Mental Health/Mental  
5 Retardation fund to provide for a program  
6 of Transitional Care Services to residents  
7 of King County, amending Ordinance No.  
8 2544, Section 49, as amended.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Unanticipated revenues received from the State  
11 of Washington Department of Social and Health Services are  
12 hereby recognized and appropriated to the Mental Health/Mental  
13 Retardation fund to provide for a program of Transitional Care  
14 Services to residents of King County. Sources of revenues and  
15 amounts are as follows:

16 DSHS Special Contract \$ 153,000

17 SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 49, as amended, is  
18 hereby amended to read as follows:

19 Mental Health/  
20 Mental Retardation ((\$5,892,907)) \$6,045,907

21 PROVIDED THAT:

- 22 1) Of this total the amount of \$115,221 intended for  
23 computer costs, staff and related expenses to be  
24 requested from the state shall not be expended until  
25 such funding is received and the project reviewed  
26 and approved by the Data Processing Policy Review  
27 Committee.

28 The Council intends that:

- 29 1. When the Center for Addiction Services grant is rewritten  
30 and the coordinating responsibility is transferred to the  
31 Division of Human Services, the appropriate funds for  
32 administration shall be likewise transferred to the  
33 County.


