ORDINANCE NO. 2660

AN ORDINANCE creating King County Road Improvement District No. 73 for underground wiring near the Sammamish Heights area.

PREAMBLE:
King County Motion No. 2308 set March 22, 1976, as the date for a hearing for the formation of a Road Improvement District for underground wiring. The provisions set forth in RCW 36.88.020, 36.88.050, 36.88.060, 36.88.410 and King County Motion No. 2308 have been met. The notice of Public Hearing was duly published and a Notice of Hearing was mailed to each property owner. It described the nature of the improvement, the total estimated cost, the estimated amount of the cost and expense to be borne by each property owner and the date and place of the hearing and the fact that property owners may withdraw their names from the petition or add their names thereto at any time prior to the day before the hearing. The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation has certified that the petition for this improvement, including all additions thereto and withdrawals therefrom made prior to 5 o'clock p.m. of the day before the hearing, is sufficient. The petition for underground wiring along 169th Avenue SE has been signed by owners of 67 percent of the lineal front footage and 62 percent of the area of the lots, and the petition along 170th Avenue SE has been signed by owners of 74 percent of the lineal front footage and 70 percent of the area of lots. A diagram or print showing the lots specially benefited by this improvement and the estimated cost and expense to be borne by each property owner, has been submitted to the Council. All written and verbal protests were considered.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. One-hundred sixty-ninth Avenue SE and 170th

Avenue SE lying south of SE 26th Street in the plats of Beaumont

Division No. 1 and Lake Crest Division No. 2 shall be improved by

the conversion of existing overhead electric and communication

facilities to underground facilities and the conversion of existing street lighting facilities to ornamental street lighting

facilities.

SECTION 2. There is hereby established a road improvement district in King County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 73". Said district shall include all the territory described as follows:

Beginning at the intersection of the Northerly extension of the West line of the plat of Beaumont Division No. 1 as recorded in volume 55 of Plats, page 92, Records of King County, Washington, and the centerline of SE 26th Street; thence Southeasterly along said centerline to its intersection

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with the Northerly extension of the centerline of Block 3 said plat of Beaumont Division No. 1; thence South along said block centerline extension and said Block 3 and continuing South along the centerline of Block 2 of Lake Crest Division No. 2 as recorded in volume 62 of Plats, page 59, Records of King County, Washington, and continuing South along the East line of Lots 7,8,9,10 and 11 of said Block 2 and its Southerly extension to the South line of the North 75 feet of the South half of Government Lot 2 of Section 12, Township 24 North, Range 5 East, W.M.; thence West along said South line 460 feet; thence North to the Southeast corner of Lot 15, Block 3 of said Lake Crest Division No. 2; thence West along the South line of Lots 15 and 16, Block 3, to the Southwest corner of Lot 16; thence North along the West line of Lot 16 to the Northwest corner thereof: thence Northwesterly across SE 29th Street to the Southwest corner of Lot 27, Block 2 of Lake Crest Division No. 1, as recorded in volume 62 of Plats, page 60, Records of King County, Washington; thence North along the West line of Lot 27 to the Northwest corner thereof; thence East along the North line of Lot 27 to the West line of Block 4 of said Lake Crest Division No. 2; thence North along said West line and its Northerly extension to the Southwest corner of Block 5 of Lake Crest Division No. 2; thence North along the West line of Block 5 and continuing North along the West line of Block 1 of said Beaumont Division No. 1 and its Norther extension to the centerline of SE 26th Street and the point of beginning.

SECTION 3: The total cost and expense to the benefiting property owners with property along 169th Avenue SE, as defined in this Ordinance, is estimated to be \$29,692.11. The total cost and expense to the benfiting property owners with property along 170th Avenue SE, as defined in this Ordinance, is estimated to

be \$27,558.90. The total cost and expense of this project will be borne by the benefiting property owners on a per building lot basis.

SECTION 4: The Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation is hereby directed to contract with Puget Sound Power and Light, Pacific Northwest Bell Telephone, and Cablevision Cable Television to convert the existing overhead electric and communication facilities to underground facilities and convert the existing street lighting facilities to ornamental street lighting facilities which are to be served from underground electrical facilities, and when the contract therefor shall have been let by King County and exact costs are known, said Director of the Department of Public Works and Transportation is further directed to prepare and file with the Clerk of the King County Council an Assessment Roll for the cost and expense of said improvements to be assessed against the property included in the assessment district herein established.

SECTION 5: There shall be and is hereby created in the Office of the King County Comptroller, two funds of the County to be known and designated as "King County Road Improvement District No. 73 Construction Fund" and "King County Road Improvement District No. 73 Bond Fund" respectively.

All moneys collected by the Comptroller upon any assessments levied for the installation of said improvement shall be placed in the said construction fund during the thirty (30) day period allowed for payment of such assessment without penalty or interest, and shall be placed in the said bond fund thereafter. Payment shall be made on the basis of the assessment roll prepared by the Department of Public Works and Transportation, subject to adjustment after completion of hearing on said roll.

The Office of Comptroller Accounting Section is hereby directed and authorized to issue interest bearing warrants against King County Road Improvement District No. 73 Construction Fund to

pay construction costs pending the redemption of said warrants į after the bond sale. The interest rate of said interest bearing 2 warrants shall not exceed six percent (6%) per annum. 3 Bonds of said Improvement District payable on or before seventeen years from date of issuance, shall be sold in the 5 amount sufficient to redeem all outstanding warrants against 6 aforesaid construction fund for that portion of the cost and expenses of the installation of said improvement to be assessed 8 against the property within the district after determining the 9 amount of such assessments paid within the thirty day period 10 allowed for payment of assessment without penalty or interest. 11 INTRODUCED AND READ for the first time this 2th day of 12 Ylakoh) 13 , 1976.
