AN ORDINANCE relating to approval of the formation of Cemetery District No. 1 and setting a date of election for the district on Vashon-Maury Island.

PREAMBLE:  
A petition requesting formation of a cemetery district on Vashon-Maury Island has been found by the Elections Division to be sufficient.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The proposed formation of a cemetery district for Vashon-Maury Island will be conducive to the public welfare and convenience.

SECTION 2. The boundaries of the proposed district to be known as Cemetery District No. 1 shall be all of the area of Vashon-Maury Islands to be established for the purpose of acquiring, owning, improving, managing and maintaining a cemetery for the public safety, welfare and convenience and for otherwise conducting any and all of the usual functions of a cemetery under the laws of the State of Washington.

SECTION 3. A special election shall be held on the 13<sup>th</sup> day of July, 1976, within the area heretofore described, between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of submitting to the qualified electors within the described area the proposition of establishing said cemetery district.

SECTION 4. In submitting said proposition to the voters for their approval or rejection, the proposition shall be expressed on the ballot in the following terms:

SECTION 5. The ballot shall specify names of candidates nominated for election as the first cemetery district commissioners with space to vote for same. Three qualified


1 electors are to be elected to serve as commissioners until the


