

ORDINANCE NO. 2750

1 AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$127,000 from the
2 Current Expense Fund unappropriated fund
3 balance for implementation of the Accounting
4 and Resources Management System (ARMS);
5 amending Ordinance 2544, Sections 15 and 43,
6 as amended.

7 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

8 SECTION 1. An appropriation of \$120,000 is hereby approved
9 and adopted to Systems Services New Development in Special Pro-
10 grams Current Expense Fund from unappropriated fund balance to
11 implement the Accounting and Resources Management System (ARMS).

12 SECTION 2. An appropriation of \$7,000 is hereby approved
13 and adopted to Program Budgets from the Current Expense Fund
14 unappropriated fund balance to implement the Accounting and
15 Resources Management System (ARMS).

16 SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 20, as amended, is
17 hereby amended to read as follows:

18 From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

19 Program Budgets ((\$514,367)) \$521,367

20 PROVIDED THAT:

21 All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2544
22 shall be fulfilled.

23 SECTION 4. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 43, as amended, is
24 hereby amended to read as follows:

25 From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

26 Special Programs ((\$3,878,713)) \$3,998,713

27 PROVIDED THAT:

28 1) Except as specified in Section 3, the Executive Contin-
29 gency of \$31,285 shall not be expended unless the
30 County Executive certifies in writing that funds are
31 available and requests that the County Council adopt
32 an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption
33 of the ordinance and signing by the Executive, funds
may be expended for the purposes specified.

2) \$25,000 is included to be expended upon motion of
the Council for Jobline Program if sufficient local
support for the program is demonstrated.

- 3) \$2,500 is included for remodeling costs for an Asian Clinic contingent upon an equal appropriation for this purpose from the City of Seattle.
- 4) \$30,000 is included to be expended for a study of the administrative structure and financing of the Health Department upon further motion of the Council and in accordance with Motion No. 2227.
- 5) \$10,000 is included to be expended upon motion of the Council to implement the recommendations adopted by the Council on the Regional Park Study.
- 6) \$50,000 is included to be expended upon motion of the Council to implement the recommendations adopted by the Council on Surface Water Management.
- 7) \$120,341 is included to be expended upon motion of the Council to support a regional planning organization as established to meet the needs of the counties, cities and towns of the Central Puget Sound Region.
- 8) \$34,000 is included to be expended upon further motion of the Council for funding of a second 12-month phase of the Rebellious Youth Project upon recommendation of the Executive if after evaluation of the project's first year, he believes the County should fund a second phase jointly with the State of Washington, the City of Seattle and United Way.
- 9) No more than \$70,000 is to be spent for consulting services associated with the Accounting and Resources Management System (ARMS) unless approved by Council motion upon recommendation of the Data Processing Policy Review Committee.

The Council intends that:

- 1. The Division of Human Services in conjunction with the Department of Budget and Program Development develop a proposal for a day care center program for the residents of King County. Alternatives to implement such a program including the use of volunteers working in cooperation with religious and community groups, shall be presented to the Health and Human Services Committee by June 1, 1976.
