KING COUNTY, WASHINGTON 2831 ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE providing for the submission to the voters of King County at a special election to be held therein on November 2, 1976, in conjunction with the State general election to be held on the same date, of a proposition authorizing the County to continue the Harborview Medical Center modernization program for the purpose of meeting community health care needs, new life safety codes and accreditation standards, to increase the patient care capacity of the burn center and to acquire new facilities and equipment for the Medical Center and authorizing the issuance of general obligation bonds of the County in the total principal amount of \$19,500,000 to pay for such County capital purposes only, such bonds to be payable by annual tax levies to be made without limitation as to rate or amount.

King County now owns and operates Harborview Medical Center for the care and treatment of the sick and injured and the facilities of this medical center are not adequate to meet the present needs for such care and treatment. If such needs are to be adequately met it is necessary that the County acquire new and improved equipment for the Medical Center, construct a modern burn treatment facility and remodel and modernize existing facilities to meet new health care needs and new life safety and accreditation standards.

The County lacks sufficient funds with which to make the needed improvements to the Medical Center and to pay the cost of such improvements it is necessary that the County incur a general indebtedness by issuing its general obligation bonds in the principal amount of \$19,500,000.

The Constitution and Laws of the State of Washington require that the question of whether the County may contract such indebtedness and issue such bonds for such purpose be submitted to the

qualified electors of the County for their ratification or rejection and the public health and safety of the residents of the County requires the holding of a special County election to authorize the issuance of such bonds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. It is hereby found and declared that it is necessary for the public health, safety and welfare of the people of King County that the County renovate and remodel the Harborview Medical Center and provide additional and new equipment therefor to enable the Medical Center to meet new health care needs and new life safety and accreditation standards and that the County constrand equip such additions to the Medical Center facilities as are necessary for such purposes including but not limited to a modern burn treatment facility with increased capacity for patient care.

SECTION 2. The estimated cost of making such improvements including all costs incident thereto is hereby declared to be as nearly as may be the sum of \$19,500,000 and to pay such costs the County shall incur a general indebtedness in the principal amount of \$19,500,000 by issuing and selling its general obligation bonds in such amount for strictly County capital purposes other than the replacement of equipment as herein provided.

SECTION 3. The bonds herein authorized to be issued shall be issued in one or more series over a period of three years, shall bear interest at an effective rate not to exceed the maximum rate permitted by law, which, except for the first interest payment, shall be payable semiannually. The bonds of each seriest shall mature as provided by law and the ordinance authorizing their sale in from not less than two to not more than twenty years from the date of issue of each seriest and the life of the improvements to be acquired and constructed from the proceeds of such bonds is hereby found and declared to be at least twenty years.

Both principal of and interest on the bonds shall be payable out of annual tax levies to be made upon all of the taxable property within the County without limitation as to rate or amount and sufficient in amount to pay such principal and interest as the same shall become due. The date, interest rate or rates, denominations, maturities, options of redemption, form and covenants of each series of such bonds shall be as hereafter fix by ordinance or motion of the King County Council in the manner provided by law.

SECTION 4. The proceeds of sale of the bonds shall be deposited in the Harborview Medical Center Construction Fund in the office of the Comptroller of King County except that any accrued interest on the bonds received at the time of their delivery shall be paid into a fund to be hereafter created for the redemption of the bonds. Moneys in such Harborview Medical Center Construction Fund may be temporarily deposited in such institution invested in such obligations as may be lawful for the investment of County moneys and may be temporarily advanced to such fund as may be created for the redemption of the bonds to pay bor interest pending receipt of taxes levied therefor.

The proceeds of sale of the bonds and any interest received from the deposit or investment of such proceeds shall be applied and used solely for the acquisition and development of Harborview Medical Center improvements and all costs incident thereto and incident to the issuance of the bonds, and none of such proceeds shall be used for other than a capital purpose.

SECTION 5. It is hereby found and declared that the urgent need for such improvements at the Harborview Medical Center has created an emergency within King County and such emergency is hereby declared to exist and the Superintendent of Elections of King County is hereby requested to also find the existence of an

emergency and to call and conduct a special County election on 1 November 2, 1976 in the manner provided by law to be held in 2 conjunction with the State general election on the same date 3 between the hours of 7:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock p.m. for the purpose of submitting to the qualified voters of the County for their ratification or rejection a proposition substantially 6 7 in the following form: . PROPOSITION 8 HARBORVIEW MEDICAL CENTER IMPROVEMENT BONDS-\$19,500,000 9 For the purpose of renovating, modern-10 izing and equipping Harborview Medical Center to meet new life safety codes and 11 accreditation standards and constructing new burn treatment facilities with increased 12 patient care capacity, shall King County, Washington issue its general obligation bonds 13 in the principal amount of \$19,500,000 to be issued in series over a period of three years, to mature in from two to not more than twenty 14 (20) years from the date of issue of each series, 15 both principal and interest to be payable from annual tax levies to be made upon all the 16 taxable property within the County without limitation as to rate or amount all as more specifically provided in Ordinance No. 283/ 17 of the County, passed and approved_ 18 BONDS . . .
