ORDINANCE NO. 2837

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Community Mental Retardation Board; changing its name to the Board for Developmental Disabilities; amending KCC 2.32.020 and Ordinance 142; amending KCC 2.32.010 and Ordinance 141; and amending KCC 2.16.160 and Ordinance 2072, Section 2.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. KCC 2.32.020 and Ordinance 142 are hereby amended as follows:

~~((Community-Mental-Retardation-Board-))~~ Board for Developmental Disabilities.

(a) CREATED. There is created a ~~((Community-Mental Retardation-Board))~~ Board for Developmental Disabilities to be known by that title, and hereinafter referred to as the Board

(b) MEMBERSHIP-APPOINTMENT. The Board shall be composed of fifteen members who shall be appointed by the County Executive and confirmed by the County Council to three year terms, or until their successor is appointed and qualified.

Membership of the Board shall be representative of but not limited to the public, private or voluntary agencies, local government units which participate in a program for ~~((mentally retarded-persons))~~ individuals with a developmental disability, and private citizens knowledgeable or interested in services to the ~~((mentally-retarded))~~ developmentally disabled in the community.

(c) COMPENSATION. Members of the Board shall not be compensated for the performance of their duties as members of the Board.

(d) DUTIES. The Board shall perform all duties and services and have all powers established by RCW 71.20 as now or hereafter amended.

(e) MEETING WITH ADMINISTRATIVE BOARD. The Community Mental Health Administrative Board and the ~~((Community-Mental Retardation-Board))~~ Board for Developmental Disabilities may meet

1 jointly or separately as required in the conduct of their programs,
2 and when convened jointly may use the designation "King County
3 Mental Health-((Mental-Retardation)) Developmental Disabilities
4 Administrative Board."

5 SECTION 2. KCC 2.32.010 and Ordinance 141 are hereby
6 amended as follows:

7 Community Mental Health Administrative Board.

8 (a) CREATED. There is hereby created a Community
9 Mental Health Administrative Board to be known by that title, and
10 hereinafter referred to as the Board.

11 (b) MEMBERSHIP-APPOINTMENT. The Board shall be
12 composed of fifteen members who shall be appointed by the County
13 Executive and confirmed by the County Council to three year terms
14 or until their successor is appointed and qualified.

15 Membership of this Board shall be representative of the
16 County Council, medical societies, local health departments,
17 superior court judges (who may select an attorney to represent
18 them), local offices of the State Department of Public Assistance,
19 hospital boards, lay associations or groups concerned with mental
20 health, labor, business and civic groups, and the general public.

21 (c) COMPENSATION. Members of the Board shall not be
22 compensated for the performance of their duties as members of the
23 Board.

24 (d) DUTIES. The Board shall perform all duties
25 established by RCW 71.24.070 as now or hereafter amended.

26 (e) SUPERVISOR-APPOINTMENT AND DUTIES. The supervisor
27 of Community Mental Health Services shall be appointed by the
28 County Executive and confirmed by the County Council, subject to
29 the approval of the Board, as specified in RCW 71.24.080. The
30 supervisor shall have all powers and duties specified by RCW
31 71.24.090 as now or hereafter amended.

32 (f) ADDITIONAL POWERS AND DUTIES. All other powers,
33 duties and responsibilities assigned, now or hereafter amended,

1 by sections of RCW 71.24 are conferred upon the Board and
2 supervisor of Community Mental Health Services.

3 (g) MEETINGS WITH ((RETARDATION-BOARD)) BOARD FOR
4 DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES. The ((Community-Mental-Retardation
5 Board)) Board for Developmental Disabilities and the Community
6 Mental Health Administrative Board may meet jointly or separately
7 as required in the conduct of their programs, and when convened
8 jointly may use the designation "King County Mental Health-
9 ((Mental-Retardation)) Developmental Disabilities Administrative
10 Board."


11 SECTION 3. KCC 2.16.160 and Ordinance 2072, Section 2, are
12 hereby amended as follows:

13 DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC HEALTH-DIVISION OF HUMAN SERVICES-
14 MEMBERSHIP. The Division of Human Services shall include a
15 manager and such staff as are necessary to accomplish its duties.
16 It shall not include the Mental Health and ((Mental-Retardation))
17 Developmental Disabilities advisory and Administrative Boards or
18 the Seattle-King County Drug Commission (hereafter referred to as
19 the Boards) or their direct and exclusive staff.
