5 AN ORDINANCE relating to flood hazard area of the Lower Cedar  
6 River Flood Plain, reclassifying existing F-P Zoning and providing  
7 for zone classifications more compatible with surrounding classifica-  
8 tions and amending Ordinance No. 00220.

9 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

10 SECTION 1. Ordinance 00220, DESCRIPTION is amended to read as follows:

11 That portion of unincorporated King County described as follows: Sections  
12 1 through 18, East 1/2 of 19, 20 through 29, East 1/2 of 31, 32, 33, Township 25  
13 North, Range 6 East W.M. (~~and Sections 1 through 36,~~) and Sections 1 through  
14 18, East 1/2 20, 21 through 28, 30 and 31, East 1/2 of 33; 34 through 36,  
15 Township 23 North, Range 6 East W.M.

16 SECTION 2. The zoning maps attached hereto, are hereby adopted pursuant  
17 to the provisions of Resolution No. 25789 and K.C.C. 21.06.070 for the area de-  
18 scribed as follows: Section 19; the west 1/2 of Section 20; Sections 29 and 32;  
19 and the West 1/2 of Section 33, all in Township 23 N; Range 6 E.W.M., commonly  
20 known as the Lower Cedar River Flood Plain.
