Bonds, 1976, and declaring an emergency. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 2808, Section 5, is hereby amended to read as follows:

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Department of Public

Works; amending Ordinance No. 2808, Section 5; providing

for the delegation by the Administrator-Clerk of the County Council of the authority to sign the attestation on the Limited General Obligation Public Works Department

SECTION 5. The bonds shall be printed or lithographed on lithographed or engraved forms and shall be signed by the facsimile signature of the County Executive of King County and attested by the Administrator-Clerk of the County Council and each of the interest coupons shall be signed with the facsimile signatures of those officials. The seal of the King County Council shall be printed in facsimile on each bond pursuant to state law. Section 850 of the King County Charter, the Administrator-Clerk may delegate to a deputy clerk his authority to sign the attestation on the bonds and coupons.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
