

ORDINANCE NO. 2887

AN ORDINANCE annexing an area known as Timberlane (P-241, Res. 245) to Cascade Sewer District.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. On June 14, 1976 the King County Council Clerk received a Notice of Intention from Cascade Sewer District indicating that Petition No. 241 to annex 30 acres of a portion of Timberlane 5 had been filed with the District. The petition contained the signatures of at least sixty percent (60%) of the area's landowners. Resolution No. 425 approving the annexation was passed on July 18, 1974 by the District's Board of Commissioners in order to correct an administrative oversight and bring into Cascade Sewer District an area which has been receiving sewer service since 1967. The District filed a Declaration of Environmental Non-Significance, dated May 4, 1976. The District has a County-approved comprehensive plan (Motion 2162, passed 9/15/75) as required by Ordinance No. 1709 as amended, and

2. The Boundary Review Board approved of the above-mentioned annexation effective August 8, 1976 after having considered the criteria set forth in RCW 36.39.170 and after having found that the proposed annexation adequately meets the objectives enumerated in RCW 36.93.180.

3. The King County Council has considered the criteria set forth in RCW 57.02.040, and has found the proposed annexation under the existing circumstances to be adequately consistent with such criteria and to be in the public interest.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by Cascade Sewer District of the area known as Timberlane (P-241, Res. 245) and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
