9 **ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_**

10 AN ORDINANCE relating to the King County Shoreline Manage-  
11 ment Master Program, providing for adoption of the policies  
12 of the Master Program as an addendum to the Comprehensive  
13 Plan and the adoption of the regulations and environment  
14 designations of the Master Program as the Shoreline Manage-  
15 ment regulations of King County.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:**

15 **SECTION 1. PURPOSE.** The purpose of this ordinance is to adopt a  
16 shoreline master program, as required by the Shoreline Management Act of  
17 1971, RCW 90.58, for all areas subject to the jurisdiction of King County. The  
18 council finds that the master program has been developed in a manner consistent  
19 with the provisions of the Shoreline Management Act, including §10 of the Act  
20 (RCW 90.58.100), and the State Environmental Policy Act, RCW 43.21C, through  
21 the utilization of county departments, other public agencies, a Citizens Advisory  
22 Committee, the Environmental Development Commission, other members of the  
23 public and all available and relevant plans, studies, surveys and inventories.  
24 The council further finds that adequate public hearings on this ordinance have  
25 been held after proper notice given and that the Department of Ecology has  
26 completed review of the Master Program as required by RCW 90.58.090 and  
27 has approved the Master Program with the exception of regulation A.6. (page  
28 97).

29 **SECTION 2. ADOPTION.** (a) The policies of the Shoreline Management  
30 Master Program, attached, are adopted as an addendum to the Comprehensive  
31 Plan for King County. As an addendum to the Comprehensive Plan, such

1 policy statements constitute the official policy of King County  
2 regarding areas of the county subject to shoreline management  
3 jurisdiction.

4 (b) The regulations and environment designations of the  
5 Shoreline Management Master Program (Attachment A), Shoreline  
6 Management Master Program Revisions (Attachment B), and  
7 Shoreline Management Master Program Supplement, including  
8 Errata (Attachment C) are adopted as the Shoreline Management  
9 regulations of King County.

10 SECTION 3. SEVERABILITY. If any provision of this ordinance  
11 or the Master Program hereby adopted or its application to any  
12 person or circumstance is declared unconstitutional or invalid  
13 for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of  
14 the remaining portions of this ordinance or the Master Program.

16 of May, 1974.
