

ORDINANCE NO. 2973

AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$65,276 to the Inter-County River Improvement Fund for flood damage repair work which resulted from the flood of December 1975, amending Ordinance No. 2544, section 47, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1: The amount of \$65,276 is hereby appropriated to the Inter-County River Improvement Fund from the Current Expense Fund balance to provide support for flood damage repair along the White River.

PROVIDED:

- a. Since the Federal Disaster Assistance Administration participates in funding flood damage repair projects maximum support should be requested to fund these projects.
- b. The scope of work performed should be limited to FDAA approved projects.
- c. Since the FDAA participates at an 85% funding level, the 15% local match should be divided between King and Pierce County. Of this amount the portion for King County is not to exceed \$9,179. With an additional \$4,082 for equipment repair in support of this work.
- d. Of the remaining amount, \$52,015 will be loaned to the Inter-County River Improvement Fund and reimbursed to King County as FDAA funds are received.
- e. The aforementioned stipulations are agreed to in an Inter Governmental contract between King and Pierce County.
