ORDINANCE NO. 2987

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AN ORDINANCE authorizing a 3 year contract for the intermediate hauling of solid waste between transfer stations and final disposal pursuant to Section 495 of the King County Charter.

WHEREAS, the Washington State 44th Legislature enacted Second Substitute House Bill 721 allowing counties to enter into contracts for the hauling of trailers containing solid waste between transfer stations and disposal sites, and

WHEREAS, prior bid experience in the intermediate hauling of solid waste between transfer stations and the Cedar Hills Regional Landfill indicated the potential for significant monetary savings to King County, and

WHEREAS, the contracting of intermediate hauling of solid waste would not be inconsistent with the King County Comprehensive Solid Waste Management Plan as adopted by the Council on October 4, 1976, and

WHEREAS, the County Council has been requested by the County Executive to adopt an ordinance permitting the County to enter into contracts requiring payment of funds from appropriations of subsequent fiscal years pursuant to Section 495 of the King County Charter,


1 BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

2 The King County Executive is hereby authorized to take all
3 steps necessary to develop a contract pursuant to RCW 36.58 of no
4 more than three years duration for the intermediate hauling of
5 solid waste between King County transfer stations and final
6 disposal. Upon determination that a substantial savings will be
7 realized thereby, the King County Executive shall document said
8 savings to the Council and present a motion for the Council's
9 consideration by which he would be authorized to execute the
10 contract.
