ORDINANCE NO. 3003 76 - 1029

AN ORDINANCE relating to the Policy
Development Commission; amending Ordinance
2208, Section 8.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 2208, Section 8, is hereby amended as follows:

Members of the Commission termed citizens-at-large shall be appointed by the County Executive from nominees of County Councilmembers and confirmed by a majority of the County Council. Citizen-at-large members shall serve for two year terms or until their successor is named and confirmed, with initial appointments following the expiration of the terms of the nine citizen-at-large members in December, 1976, of five citizen-at-large members being for two years and four being for one year. ((and-shall-be-eligible for-reappointment.)) Citizen-at-large members shall be eligible for reappointment following a critical review by the Council and Executive.

The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Commission shall be appointed by the County Executive and subject to Council The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the confirmation. Commission shall serve for two year terms or until their successor is named and confirmed, with initial appointment following the expiration of the terms of the Chairperson and Vice Chairperson in December, 1976, of the Chairperson being for two years and the Vice Chairperson being for one year. The Chairperson and Vice Chairperson of the Commission shall be eligible for reappoint ment following a critical review by the Executive and Council. Committee Chairpersons shall be appointed by the County Executive and subject to Council confirmation, except that should the Council choose to nominate a committee chairperson the Council may do so, providing that the Executive may make an appointment for the next citizen-at-large vacancy on the Commission, effective upon confirmation of the County Council. Committee Chairpersons shall serve for two year terms or until their
