ORDINANCE NO. 3006

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AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$4,000,000 of "Limited General Obligation Public Works Department Bonds, 1976" proceeds to the Renton Maintenance Facility Construction Fund for acquisition, construction and installation of the office and repair shop consolidation facility for the Department of Public Works, amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 67, Attachment No. 1, and Section 68, as amended, and establishing the project to be known as "Consolidated Office and Shop Facility (Renton Site) - 400576."

PREAMBLE: On September 13, 1976, bids for the purchase of "Limited General Obligation Public Works Department Bonds - 1976" were received by King County for \$8,350,000 par value bonds. Ordinance No. 2808, Section 8, required that \$4,000,000 principal proceeds received from the sale of said bonds shall be deposited in the "Renton Maintenance Facility Construction Fund No. 385", and shall be expended to accomplish the work outlined in Ordinance No. 2808, Section 1 (a), for the King County Department of Public Works - Consolidated Office and Shop Facility. Also, it is intended that the Consolidated Office and Shop Facility will not affect specific works units (i.e. Special Services, Soil Testing and Utility Inspection) which are to remain in the geographic area of Redmond at this time, and is not intended to alter the present or future Roads Division organization.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Department of Public Works and Transportation, Capital Improvement Program, Renton Maintenance Facility Construction Fund (No. 385), \$4,000,000 for construction and equipping the total office and repair shop facilities, amending Ordinance 2544, Section 67, Attachment No. 1.

SECTION 2. The project description attached herewith as "Attachment 1" to revise the Transportation Program, Capital Budget and Program 1976-1981, for the Department of Public Works and Transportation, and amending Ordinance No. 2544, Section 67, Attachment No. 1, is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2544, Section 68, as amended is hereby amended to read:
