

ORDINANCE NO. 3018

AN ORDINANCE increasing the number of members of the King County Arts Commission, amending Ordinance 1991, Section 3 and K.C.C. 2.48.030, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance 1991, Section 3 and K.C.C. 2.48.030 are hereby amended to read as follows:

The membership of the Arts Commission shall be (~~increased from twelve (12) to sixteen (16)~~) eighteen (18) members. Two members shall be appointed for their knowledge of historical societies' programs. Such appointive positions shall be for three years respectively (~~(7-provided-that, initial appointments of the additional four (4) members shall expire on December 15, 1976)~~). Vacancies on the Arts Commission shall be filled in the same manner as described herein; provided further, that one member of the County Council shall be appointed annually to serve as an ex officio member of the Arts Commission.

SECTION 2. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.
