ordinance no. 3639

AN ORDINANCE allowing the creation of a CETA funded Driver position for Alcoholism Services; amending Ordinance 2988, Section 52; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A CETA funded Driver position for Alcoholism Services is hereby approved and adopted.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2988, Section 52, is hereby amended to read as follows:

<u>Public Service Employment</u> - From the Public Service Employment Fund there is hereby appropriated:

\$2,447,874

## PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) No expenditure of these funds shall be made except for positions and associated benefit costs approved by Ordinance or Motion of the Council.
- The Budget Division shall not begin a proposed "fiscal management study -- phase II" using staff funded through CETA until a specific plan for such study is reviewed and approved by Council motion. The plan is to include a description of the study, specific work tasks, resources required for the study, and a detailed schedule.
- 3) Five full-time in-patient workers and three half-time peer counselors shall be funded through CETA for the juvenile alcoholism program.
- 4) The subsidized custodial training program for disadvantaged youth begun under the supervision of the Juvenile Court in 1976 shall be continued during 1977, funded at approximately \$35,000 through CETA.

5) A driver shall be funded through CETA for Alcoholism Services.
SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares
that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary
for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety
or for the support of county government and its existing public
institutions.
