AN ORDINANCE appropriating \$54,806 of additional revenue from the State Department of Social and Health Services to the Alcoholism Fund to provide for expansion of the Emergency Service Patrol and to provide outpatient services to the residents of Vashon Island, amending Ordinance No. 2988 Section 49 and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation of \$54,806 in additional revenue from the State Department of Social and Health Services to the Alcoholism Fund to provide for expansion of the Emergency Service Patrol and to provide outpatient services to the residents of Vashon Island.

SECTION 2. Ordinance 2988, Section 49 is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Alcoholism Fund there is hereby appropriated:

(-\$3,940,650) \$3,995,456

Provided that:

All provisos and intent items adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2988, Section 49 shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this Ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety, or for the support of County government and its existing public institutions.
