AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the maximum amount of \$80,135 from a State of Washington Referendum 29 Grant award to the Grant Fund for the White Center Sheltered Workshop Capital Improvement Project No. 004100; revising the 1977 Capital Improvement Budget and Program and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, Attachment No. 1, as amended, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the maximum amount of \$80,135 from a State of Washington Referendum 29 Grant award to the Grant Fund, County File No. 649, for the White Center Sheltered Workshop Capital Improvement Project No. 004100.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

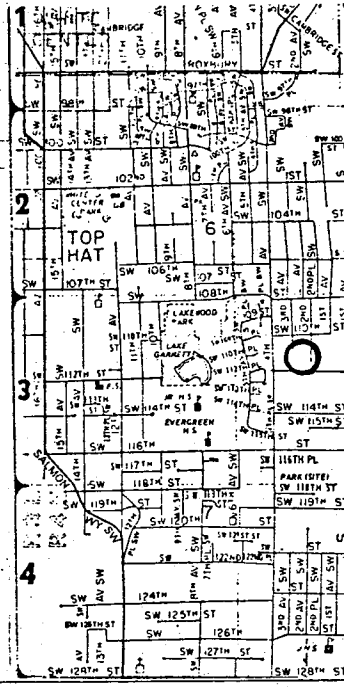
