AN ORDINANCE relating to the Vacation of a portion of N. E. 157th Street W-1510
Petitioner: Mark Walliamson and Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of N. E. 157th Street, hereinafter described.
- 2. The Department of Public Works has investigated the petitioned vacation. The various utilities serving the area were notified and they advised that easements are not required.
- 3. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the subject proposed road vacation and found that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation.
- 4. The area petitioned for vacation is a portion of the Plat of the Bronson Addition to Kirkland, recorded on December 5, 1890. When platted, it was designated Montrose Street. There is no evidence that the subject area has ever been opened as a road.
- 5. There is no evidence that the County has spent funds for its acquisition or maintenance, therefore, the right-of-way would be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 6. The Department of Public Works and the Division of Building and Land Development consider the subject right-of-way useless as part of the County road system and believe the public would benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by Law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 2/5t day of Malch, 1977.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING: SECTION 1. The Council on the 0.2/5t day of 0.2/5t day of 0.2/5t, 1977,

hereby vacates and abandons a portion of N. E. 157th Street, described as follows: That portion of N. E. 157th Street also known as Montrose Street, lying easterly of the east margin of 158th Avenue N.E. and lying westerly of the west margin of 160th Avenue N.E.; ALSO described as lying between lots 6 and 7 of the Bronson Addition to Kirkland as recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington. The subject area contains approximately 36,677 square feet.
