AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$22,000 from the Executive Contingency in Special Programs to provide a fire escape at the Youth Service Center; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Sections 41 and 70, Attachment No. 1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$22,000 from the Executive Contingency in Special Programs for transfer to the Youth Services Facilities Fund to provide a fire escape for the Girls' Delinquent Wing at the Youth Service Center; Capital Improvement Project No. 006024.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 41, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

From the Current Expense Fund there is hereby appropriated to:

Special Programs \$5,888,277

PROVIDED THAT:

- 1) The Executive Contingency of (~~(\$165,916)~~) \$143,916 shall not be expended unless the County Executive certifies in writing that funds are available and requests that the County Council adopt an additional appropriation ordinance; upon adoption of the ordinance and signing by the Executive, funds may be expended for the purposes specified.

All provisos adopted by the Council in Ordinance No. 2988 shall be fulfilled.

SECTION 3. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Youth Services Facilities \$ 22,000

SECTION 4. The project information sheet attached hereto is adopted to amend and revise the King County 1977 Capital Improvement Budget; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, attachment No. 1, as amended.

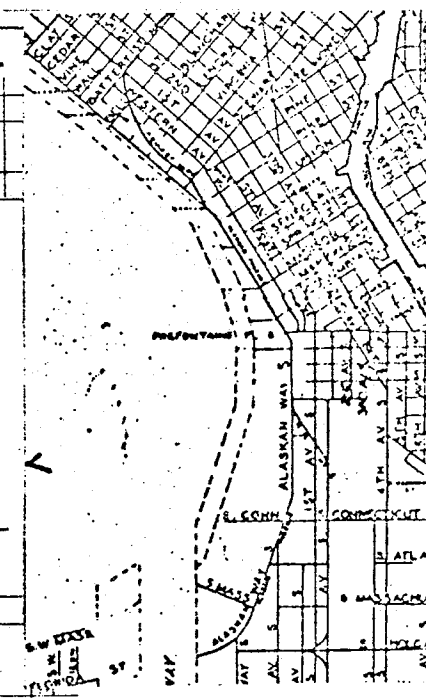
