AN ORDINANCE relating to per diem for the Board of Appeals, amending Ordinance No. 509, Section 1 and K.C.C. 2.32.090.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. Ordinance No. 509, Section 1, and K.C.C. 2.32.090 are amended to read as follows:

Board of Appeals to heal appeals on property taxes and business licenses - per diem allowance.

- (a) In conformity with the new specifications of Chapter 55, 41st
  Legislature, 2nd Extra Session, and in addition to those powers relating to
  valuation provided for in Charter Section 720, the Board of Appeals shall
  hear and decide all appeals and such other matters specified by RCW 84.48.010
  (relating to the July Board of Equalization) RCW 84.56.390, RCW 84.56.400
  (relating to the treasurer's June Board of Equalization), and RCW 84.52.090
  (relating to the assessor's November Board of Equalization) as amended to
  July 1, 1970. Any member disqualified by Section 3 of said Chapter 55 may
  obtain temporary leave of absence by order of the County Executive or his
  designee in the premises.
- (b) The Board of Appeals shall hear and decide all appeals resulting from the denial, suspension or revocation of business licensing.
- (c) For time devoted to official work of the Board of Appeals, each member thereof shall receive a per diem allowance of ((fifty-dollars)) seventy-five dollars, provided that a per diem allowance of ((twenty-five dollars)) thirty-five dollars shall be paid for official board work of ((three)) four hours or less.
- (d) Decisions of the King County assessor in taxpayer claims for relief of taxes and assessments on real or personal property destroyed by fire or act of God, as provided for in Chapter 120 Laws of 1975, 1st
