AN ORDINANCE relating to the Vacation of a portion of 230th Avenue S.E. V-1519
Petitioner: Lakeside Gravel Company, Inc. & Others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting a vacation of a portion of 230th Avenue S.E., hereinafter described.
- 2. In compliance with the Council's letter dated May 26, 1976, the Department of Public Works and the Building and Land Development Division have investigated the petitioned vacation area.
- 3. The Department of Public Works advise that the road was established in 1895 (County Road No. 272). They have contacted the several utilities serving the area and were advised that easements have been secured by Puget Power and Washington Natural Gas Company.
- 4. The Building and Land Development Division reports that the granting of the vacation petition would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of the proposed vacation.
- 5. The vacation petition is in conformance with the terms of a right of way deed which the Real Property Division has secured from Lakeside Gravel Company, Inc., the petitioner. This deed grants to King County certain lands adjacent to the S.E. Issaquah-Fall City Road. These lands contain 52,200 square feet more or less. The petitioned vacation area contains 25,050 square feet more or less.
- 6. It is believed that the public will benefit by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls and by the acquisition of the lands adjacent to the S.E. Issaquah-Fall City Road.

Due notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 25 day of Opril, 1977.

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION 1. The Council on the 25 day of 4pril, 1977, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of 230th Avenue S.E., described
