ORDINANCE NO. 3186

AN ORDINANCE relating to the vacation of a portion of N.E. 159th St.

Petitioner: Walter Smith and others

STATEMENT OF FACTS

- 1. A petition has been filed requesting vacation of a portion of N.E. 159th St., hereinafter described.
- 2. The Division of Building and Land Development has studied the proposed road vacation and finds that it would not be in conflict with the principles and purposes of the King County Comprehensive Plan and the specific plans in the vicinity of this proposed vacation.
- 3. The Department of Public Works notified the various utilities serving the area and were advised that easements are not required.
- 4. The vacation area is a portion of the plat of The Bronson Addition to Kirkland, recorded December 5, 1890. The Department of Public Works found no evidence that the vacation area has ever been open as a road. A search of the records indicate that the County has spent no funds for its acquisition or maintenance, therefore, right of way would be classified "C Class" in accordance with County Ordinance No. 2759.
- 5. The Department of Public Works considers the subject right of way useless as part of the County Road system and believe that the public would be benefited by the return of this unused area to the public tax rolls.

Due Notice was given in the manner provided by law and a hearing was held by the King County Council on the 25^{th} day of Upril

In consideration of the benefits to be derived from the subject vacation, the Council has determined that it is in the best interest of the citizens of King County to grant said petition,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE COUNTY OF KING:

SECTION 1. The Council on the 25^{\pm} day of \sqrt{pril} , 19 27, hereby vacates and abandons the portion of N.E. 159th St., described as follows:

> All that portion of N.E. 159th St. (Princess St.) lying easterly of the east right of way margin of 152nd Ave. N.E. (Atlantic Ave.) and westerly of the west right of way margin of 154th Ave. N.E. (Woodin Ave.) as shown on

the plat of The Bronson Addition to Kirkland as recorded in Volume 6 of Plats, page 96, records of King County, Washington. Area contains approximately 35,690 square feet.
