Ordinance No. 3190

AN ORDINANCE relating to the costs and benefits of King County Road Improvement District No. 67 for underground wiring in the Innis Arden Area and adding a new section to Ordinance No. 2272.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. A new section is hereby added to Ordinance No. 2272 as follows:

"NEW SECTION. SECTION 6. It is hereby found that the plan of improvement or construction in Road Improvement District No. 67 is feasible and that the benefits to be derived therefrom by the property within said district, together with the amount of any King County road fund participation, exceed the costs and expense of the formation of said district and the contemplated construction or improvement therein."
