ORDINANCE NO.

AN ORDINANCE making an appropriation in the amount of \$12,750,000 to the Harborview Medical Center Construction Fund 1977 from the proceeds of the sale of "General Obligation Hospital Bonds, 1977", as authorized by Ordinance No. 3021, to establish budgets in the amount of \$7,500,000 for the North Wing Addition; \$3,000,000 for the Modernization of Ambulatory Services; \$2,000,000 for the Modernization of Radiology Services and \$250,000 for a Program Contingency; revising the 1977 Harborview Medical Center Capital Improvement Budget and amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, Attachment #1, as amended.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$12,750,000 to the Harborview Medical Center Construction Fund - 1977 from the proceeds of the sale of "General Obligation Hospital Bonds, 1977", to establish budgets in the amount of \$7,500,000 for the North Wing Addition C.I.P. Project No. 008240; \$3,000,000 for the Modernization of Ambulatory Services C.I.P. Project No. 008245; \$2,000,000 for the Modernization of Radiology Services C.I.P. Project No. 008250 and \$250,000 for a Program Contingency C.I.P. Project No. 008255.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 70, as amended, is hereby amended to read as follows:

Harborview Medical Center Construction Fund - 1977

SECTION 3. As part of the North Wing Addition (Project 008240), plans for construction of additional space for psychiatric services shall take into account the need to serve prisoner patients from the county jail. Such plans may include expansion of the capacity to provide intensive care, additional locked rooms or wards or such other physical arrangements as appropriate to accomplish the treatment of said prisoner patients. The architects shall in conjunction with the administration of

-

Harborview Hospital, the King County Department of Rehabilitative Services and the King County Department of Health prepare a functional plan and an estimate of the cost of the construction of a twelve-bed jail ward for the care of medical, surgical and psychiatric prisoner patients within or immediately adjacent to Harborview Hospital.

Modernization of Ambulatory Service (Project 008245) will include, by remodeling or new construction, space acceptable to King County for the provision of alcoholism triage services required by the King County Alcoholism Services Program. This space shall be located so as to provide efficient service to alcoholism patients while reducing interference with the provision of other services to the public.


