ORDINANCE NO. 3243

2 AN ORDINANCE making appropriations to the
3 CETA Title II Fund, CETA Title VI Fund, and
4 establishing a new CETA Title VI Project
Employment Fund, and amending Ordinance 2988,
Section 52, as amended.

PREAMBLE:

King County has received an additional \$3,167,564 in grant funds from the Department of Labor through the King/Snohomish Manpower Consortium for the continuation of its current Title II and Title VI Programs and for the creation of a Title VI Project Employment Program.

The funds are distributed as follows:

\$ 76,614 in Title II '77 Discretionary Funds
\$1,093,295 in Title II '77 Economic Stimulus Funds
\$ 119,547 in Title VI '77 Discretionary Funds
\$1,878,108 in Title VI '77 Economic Stimulus Funds

Title II funds will be used to continue existing positions through September 1977 and to create 152 new positions. Title VI funds will be used to continue existing positions through September 1977 and create 572 new Project Employment positions.

A separate fund is created for Title VI Project Employment appropriating the amount of the new funds that is not needed for sustaining the current Title VI Program. In addition, this ordinance corrects the 1976 carryover amount of \$2,447,874 appropriated in Ordinance 2988, Section 52, reducing this amount to \$1,691,342. Appropriating the new Title II funds results in a Title II Program amount for FY '77 of \$2,861,251.

SECTION 1. The CETA Title II 216 fund is hereby increased to a total of \$2,861,251. The amount of \$2,447,874 previously appropriated by Ordinance 2988, Section 52, to the Title II Fund 216 is hereby reduced by \$756,532 to reflect actual carryover of funds for 1976.

The amount of \$76,614 in FY '77 Discretionary Title II funds and the amount of \$1,093,295 in FY '77 Economic Stimulus funds are hereby appropriated to the CETA Title II Fund 216 from the King/Snohomish Manpower Consortium to sustain the current employment program an additional 152 new positions are created, as shown in the attachment.

SECTION 2. The amount of \$1,170,876 is hereby appropriated to the CETA Title VI Fund 243 from the King/Snohomish Manpower Consortium to sustain the current Title VI employment program.

1 SECTION 3. The amount of \$826,779 is hereby appropriated
 2 to a new CETA Title VI Project Employment Fund from the King/
 3 Snohomish Manpower Consortium. 572 positions are created under
 4 project employment, as listed in the attachment.

5 PROVIDED THAT:

6 The Program Development Division may make adjustments to
 7 the approved projects during contract negotiations. The Council
 8 will be informed of any approved projects not subsequently funded
 9 due to legal, program or operational problems.







CETA FUNDING RECOMMENDATION

Narrative Summary

A. Authorizing Legislation

On May 13 the CETA section of the 1977 economic stimulus package was enacted. This 6.5 billion dollar measure will add 415,000 nationally new jobs in the next few months to CETA's public service employment components. The legislation raises the funding level of Title II of CETA from 400 million to 1.5 billion dollars and will double the number of public service jobs funded under this title. The major thrust of the legislation, however, is in the expansion of Title VI of the Act. Funding under this title is increased from 1.4 billion to 6.8 billion dollars. Some of this money is to be used to sustain current Title VI employment levels, but most will be used to create new jobs in public employment projects. The following table compares current FY 1977 allocations with the amounts added by the economic stimulus bill.

B. Funding Period

This legislation appropriates funding for the remainder of Fiscal Year 1977 and forward funds Fiscal Year 1978. The portion funding the last four months of FY'77 has been made immediately available, but the larger 1978 share is being held for a thirty day comment period on the new legislation. For this reason, this recommendation package covers only the four-month period of June through September of 1977. When the additional monies are released and

required, the Public Employment Program (PEP) will approach the Executive and Council for additional funding authorization.

C. Programmatic Concerns

All funding recommendations are made subject to the establishment and continued maintenance of host agency and individual position eligibility. The Public Employment Program will not complete or will terminate County contracts with agencies which are found to be in serious and irreversible violation of federal or local regulations. PEP will assist agencies to develop required capabilities, but those that cannot meet the minimal standards, even with assistance, will not receive the positions recommended herein.

D. Title II Funding Plan

This recommendation adds 152 new positions to the employment level which is currently maintained under Title II. The cost of these new positions for the remainder of FY'77 is \$515,141. This addition will bring County Title II funding authorization for FY'77 up to a cumulative total of \$2,308,369 and 396 individual jobs.



The purpose of the economic stimulus legislation for Title II is to first ensure that current enrollment levels can be sustained through September of 1978 and then to add immediately as many new jobs as can be maintained throughout the remainder of the two-year period. Although the 152 positions added in this recommendation will not expend in FY'77 all of the funds immediately available for new jobs, the remaining money (\$403,316) will have to be added to the 1978 allocation to sustain this optimum level through 1978. As is shown in the following graph, this enrollment level, permitting a normal attrition phase-down beginning in October, will expend all of the funds available during the two-year period.

CETA TITLE II FUNDING PLAN



The 152 new Title II positions have been distributed to each of the five Sub-Agent groups according to allocation formula approved by the Council last year. This formula is as follows:

County Departments and Divisions	19.6%
Cities	17.4%
School Districts	27.5%
Other Public Agencies	11.1%
Non-Profit Agencies	24.4%
Total	100.0%

Within each of these groups individual allocations are recommended primarily on the basis of each position's score on a standard application form. When positions were requested under both the Title II and the Title VI Projects formats, and scored well enough to be recommended under both, the position was recommended under Title VI only. Because of the overwhelming number of requests from non-profit agencies (453 requests for 37 available positions), positions are recommended on a one-per-agency basis and on the basis of score.

E. Title VI Funding Plan

As in the Title II portion, first priority for allocations under the Title VI section of the economic stimulus package is reserved for continuation of current enrollment levels. The remaining available money is to be used to create new jobs in employment projects. Because this "project" mode is covered by new legislation, funding for it will not be made available until completion of the thirty-day comment period on the new legislation. King County will not require all of the funds which have been made immediately available to sustain its current Title VI enrollment, so some project jobs may begin immediately.

Because "project" jobs may last only twelve months, a portion of the total funding available for projects has been retained for a future funding cycle. This will enable the County to fund positions throughout the sixteen-month period and will prevent a dramatic phase-out of all project jobs next summer. We anticipate reopening the project application process in August.

A total of 572 positions are recommended for funding for a total expenditure of \$5,745,126. This represents 72% of all the positions requested and 74% of the funds requested.

Department of Labor regulations relating to Project Employment mandate an application process that defines a stronger role for the Citizen Advisory Council of the Prime Sponsor, in this case, the Employment & Training Advisory Committee (ETAC) of the King/Snohomish Manpower Consortium (KSMC). In order to comply with the new regulations and have a somewhat uniform application process among the four Program Agents, KSMC, the Prime Sponsor, established the following process:

1. General criteria to be used in rating proposals were developed through the coordinated efforts of the four Program Agents (King County, Seattle, Snohomish County and the State Department of Employment Security) and the KSMC. Specific criteria on Public Service needs were developed by each Program Agent separately. In King County Public Service Need criteria were developed by a Task Force of County Executive and Council Staff.
2. The criteria were then reviewed and approved by the County Executive and the County Council, the ETAC and the Executive Committee of KSMC.
3. Proposals were solicited and received by KSMC and then distributed to the appropriate Program Agents.
4. A separate seven-member panel was created to individually read and rate all proposals received by each Program Agent, using the approved criteria. In King County the panel consisted of two members of ETAC, four County representatives and one KSMC staff member.
5. Scores of the seven-panel members were combined and averaged, producing a list of projects in order of score ranking. The panel decided jointly which projects were to be recommended for funding based upon score. A cut-off score was established below which projects were not recommended for funding. The cut-off score was based upon the guideline established in the criteria that projects scoring below the mean not be funded and on the quality of the proposals. The resulting cut-off score was thus determined to be 65.0.

The panel's recommendations are listed separately 1) in score order and 2) alphabetically by agency name.

Recommendations are presently being reviewed by the ETAC as well as by King County. Following King County Council review, the recommendations will be forwarded to the Executive Committee of KSMC where final decisions will be made.

Projects finally approved by the Executive Committee will still require further investigation to be certain that they meet all

Federal requirements and specifications. Several projects have been identified as having possible legal or procedural problems which will need to be resolved before contracts are awarded.
