ORDINANCE NO. 3249

AN ORDINANCE appropriating an additional \$22,229 to the County Operating Road Fund from additional permit fee revenues in response to increased platting activity; amending Ordinance No. 2988, Section 42; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated \$22,229 to the County Operating Road Fund from additional permit fee revenues to provide for additional positions required as a result of increased platting activity.

SECTION 2. Ordinance No. 2988, Section 42 is hereby amended to read as follows:

County Roads ({\$14,894,874}) \$14,917,103

SECTION 3. The County Council finds as a fact and declares that an emergency exists and that this ordinance is necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health or safety or for the support of county government and its existing public institutions.

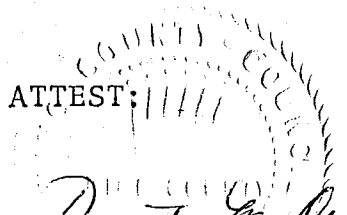
