BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

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SECTION 1. There is hereby approved and adopted an appropriation in the amount of \$850,000 to the Grant Fund from the Washington State Department of Ecology, Referendum 26, Grant No. 263361026 for design and construction of the Bow Lake Transfer Station, Grant File No. 671/108.
