ORDINANCE NO. 3277

AN ORDINANCE relating to the annexation of an area known as Monohan Park to King County Water District No. 82.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the annexation of an area known as Monohan Park to King County Water District No. 82 was filed with the County Council effective December 6, 1976.

2. King County Water District No. 82 has found the petitions for annexation to be sufficient and has, by Resolutions 302 and 305, concurred with the proposed annexation.

3. King County Water District No. 82 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated October 13, 1976, on the proposed annexation.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 18th day of April, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The annexation by King County Water District No. 82 of the area known as Monohan Park and described in Section 2 herein is approved.

SECTION 2. The area known as Monohan Park to be annexed is described as follows:

Government Lot 2 in the Southwest 1/4 of Section 8, T 24 N, R 6 E, W.M.

AND All of Government Lot 1

AND that portion of Government Lot 2 in Section 17, T 24 N, R 6 E, W.M. described as follows:

1 Beginning at the intersection of the West line of said
2 Government Lot 2 and the Centerline of the Issaquah-
3 Redmond Road No. 1011; thence Southeasterly along said
4 Centerline to the intersection of a line whose
5 Northerly projection bears N 20-16-11 E from a point
6 which lies on the Southwesterly margin of the Railroad
7 R/W Arc a distance of 344 feet, when measured along
8 said R/W Arc, from the intersection of said R/W margin
9 and the West line of Government Lot 2; thence
10 S 20-16-11 W to the Easterly shore line of lake
11 Sammamish; thence northwesterly along said shore line to
12 the West line of Government Lot 2; thence North along
13 said West line to its intersection with the centerline
14 of the Issaquah-Redmond Road No. 1011 and the Point of
15 Beginning, containing 40.5 Acres more or less.
