ORDINANCE NO. 3280

AN ORDINANCE relating to the withdrawal of an area known as Kennison, et al. from King County Water District No. 83.

STATEMENT OF FACT:

1. A notice of intention proposing the withdrawal of an area known as Kennison, et al. from King County Water District No. 83 was filed with the County Council effective March 7, 1977.

2. King County Water District No. 83 has found the petition for withdrawal to be sufficient and has, by Resolution 198, concurred with the proposed withdrawal.

3. King County Water District No. 83 filed a Declaration of Environmental Nonsignificance dated February 21, 1977, on the proposed withdrawal.

4. The County Council held a public hearing on the 13th day of June, 1977, to consider the criteria set forth in RCW 56.02.060.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF KING COUNTY:

SECTION 1. The withdrawal from King County Water District No. 83 of the area known as Kennison, et al. and described in Section 2 herein is approved.
